TRANSFER POLICY FOR THIS SPECIALITY AND TRIALS: The club will permit a transfer to the next level class in accordance with AKC regulations. The request for a TRANSFER must be made in writing and presented to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the specified event, show or trial. Transfer forms will be available at the Show Secretary's Table. For Conformation classes, transfers must be made by Thursday, October 17, 2024.

Your dog's age for Regular and Non-Regular Conformation entry is calculated as of Thursday, October 17, 2024. In Addition: Any age related Regular and Non-regular Conformation Class entry will determine the age appropriate entry in the Sweepstake Classes.

# Sled Dog Classes

# Sled Dog Class Dogs and Bitches may NOT be neutered or spayed

Sled Dog Class, Non-Degreed: A class for dogs and a class for bitches that have completed the necessary miles and/or races during the previous racing season to be eligible to enter the Sled Dog class (as defined below) but have not earned any of the SHCA sledding titles; or that have a "5 year proof" certificate. Sled Dog Class, SD Degreed: A class for dogs and a class for bitches that have earned the SHCA title of Sled Dog (SD) but have not earned any of other SHCA Sledding titles (SDX or SDO).

Sled Dog Class, SDX Degreed: A class for dogs and a class for bitches that have earned the SHCA title of Sled Dog Excellent (SDX).

Sled Dog Class, SDO Degreed: A class for dogs and a class for bitches that have earned the SHCA title of Sled Dog Outstanding (SDO).

# **Sled Dog Class Rules**

- 1. Entry must be an American Kennel Club or Canadian Kennel Club registered Siberian Husky (eligible under Chapter 15, Section 1, AKC Rules Applying to Registration & Dog Shows).
- 2. There will be a class for dogs and a class for bitches. At the discretion of the Show Chair additional classes may be offered based on the requirements of the Sled Dog Degreed Program.
- 3. If entered in a class for which a full entry fee was paid, no additional fee will be required to also exhibit in the Sled Dog class. The entry fee to exhibit solely in the Sled Dog class is free.
- 4. To qualify for entry in the Sled Dog Class, the dog must have completed one of the following three requirements:
- a)During the previous racing season, the applicant must complete ten (10) heats on snow with a minimum of four (4) miles per heat, or the total miles per season not being less than of the 48 miles up to 12 miles (25%) can come from Dryland Rig Races but the applicant must complete at least two (2) heats with a minimum of three (3) miles per heat. Dryland races must be on rigs. Rigs used must meet the definition of rig as defined by ISDRA (International Sled Dog Racing Association) under Dryland Races Rules. All races both snow and dry land must be under the direction of a Recognized Race giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A Race Season is from April 1 to March 31 of the following year.
- b) Entries who complete five (5) years in competition where the above rules are met shall be automatically qualified for the Sled Dog Class. A certificate of proof may be issued by the Chair of the Working Committee is the five (5) years of proof of competition records are sent in.
- c) Entries who have been awarded an SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either SD, SDX, or SDO and are additionally eligible for entry in a conformation class at an AKC event, are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog Class.
- 5. Spayed or neutered dogs are not exhibited in the sled dog class as required by the SHCA Standing Rules.

A list of the races in which the dog competed, or a copy of the five year certificate or a copy of the Sled Dog Degree must be sent to the Show Superintendent when the entry is made. Proof of qualification must be available at ringside with one of these shown is challenged.

The Show Superintendent shall request the following be provided with each entry to the Sled Dog Class: Each Dog's AKC Registered Name, AKC Registered Number, Sex, Race and Date of Race, miles per heat and Total miles,

or five (5) year proof certificate, or copy of the Sled Dog Degree. Revised March 2016

# **Non-regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries**

Note: As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

Stud Dog Class – For Stud Dogs and two (2) of their get. Stud Dogs may be entered in one of the Regular Classes, Performance Classes, or Best of Breed Competition. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes, Performance Classes or Best of Breed Competition.

<u>Brood Bitch</u> – Same as the Stud Dog, except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "Get".

<u>Brace Class</u> – The Brace Class shall be for two dogs of at least one identical owner or coowner regardless of sex. The two dogs comprising the Brace shall be considered a unit and they must be named at the time of entry. If a dog, which is to be part of a brace is not entered in a regular, non-regular class or Best of Breed Competition, the dog must be entered for "Brace Class Only." In making entries for Brace Class only, full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as a part of a brace, MUST be marked accordingly in the space provided for ADDITIONAL CLASSES – "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the identical owner, the dogs comprising EACH brace must be designated, "Brace No.1", "Brace No.2", etc. Please submit Brace entries together.

<u>Team</u> – Same for Brace Class, except it will be for four dogs of the same breed, with at least one identical owner or co-owner.

Please Note: In making entries for Brace or Team, the other entries comprising the unit must be identified on the entry form for each dog.

# JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

Novice Junior 9 & under 12 years Novice Intermediate 12 and under 15 years Novice senior 15 & under 18 years Open Junior 9 and under 12 years Open Intermediate 12 & under 15 years Open Senior 15 & under 18 years Master

Novice Class – Shall be for boys or girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close and have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class – shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class – for boys and girls who are least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing to the Superintendent or Show Secretary

named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master class to Open Class or Open Class to Novice Class if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placement, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Notice: Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC 919 233-9767.

Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes are entered on the front and back of the entry form, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

# **Special Attractions**

Best Bred By Exhibitor Adult, Non-Champion: The best Bred by Exhibitor Dog Adult will be chosen from the winners of the Bred by Exhibitor Adult Dog and Bred by Exhibitor Adult Bitch classes following the judging of Best of Breed on Saturday

Best Bred By Exhibitor Puppy Non-Champion: The best Bred by Exhibitor Puppy will be chosen from the winners of the Bred by Exhibitor Puppy Dog Puppy and Bred by Exhibitor Puppy Bitch classes following the judging of Best of Breed on Saturday. Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy may not compete in the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor Adult nor the Best Puppy competition.

<u>Best Puppy</u>: The best Puppy will be chosen from the winners of the Puppy Dog 6-9 months class, the Puppy Dog 9-12 months class, the Puppy Bitch 6-9 months class, the Puppy Bitch 9-12 months class, the Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy Dog class and Bred-by-Exhibitor Puppy Bitch class following the judging of Best of Breed on Saturday.

Best Veteran: The best Veteran will be chosen from the winners of the Veteran Dog 9-11 years class, the Veteran Dog 11-13 years class, the Veteran Dog Over 13 years class, the Veteran Bitch 9-11 years class, the Veteran Bitch 11-13 years class, the Veteran Bitch Over 13 years class following the judging of Best of Breed on Saturday.

Best Sled Dog: The Best Sled Dog will be chosen from the winners pf the Non-Degreed Sled Dog class, the SD Sled Dog class, the SDX Sled Dog class, the SDO Sled Dog class, and of the Best Sled Dog Classes and the winner of the Non-Degreed Sled Bitch class, the SD Sled Bitch class, the SDX Sled Bitch class, the SDO Sled Bitch class, following the judging of Best of Breed on Saturday.

# **AKC National Owner-Handler Series (NOHS):**

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a Non-Titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled series by Professional handler\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog. Dogs/bitches must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the weekend, however, current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship may participate in NOHS.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed, will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition, including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the winners of the non-regular classes.

\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handler's organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves a handling for pay within the last five years.

#### Points Available for Reserve

The Siberian Husky Club of America, Inc., will award at its 2024 National Specialty a three (3) point major to Reserve Winners Dog and/or Reserve Winner Bitch if the regular class dog/bitch entry is twice the required number for a five-point major. This occurs in the division where the National Specialty is held. In COLORADO, a five (5) point major for dogs is 7 dogs, a five (5) point major in bitches is 8 bitches.

## **Obedience and Rally Trials**

"Dog" means either sex. Qualifying Score required for all prizes in Regular and Optional Titling Classes. Move-ups will be allowed per AKC Rules and Regulations. No bitches in season may compete. Veteran Class – Open to Siberians who are at least seven (7) years old or over as the opening day of the show. You are expected to understand the Obedience and Rally rules, and understand which Class "A" or "B" at any level to enter. The rules differ between the Novice class and Advanced/Excellent classes. Be advised that your leg will not count if you earn it in the wrong class.

Entry fees will be refunded for females in season; however, a processing fee may be retained by the Club (obedience regulations: Chapter 1, Section 14). A refund of all but \$10.00 for bitches in season upon presentation of a written statement from a veterinarian to the Superintendent no later than 30 minutes before the beginning of regular class judging.

# **4-6 MONTH BEGINNER PUPPY COMPETITION**

Section 1- Classifications: The Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event.

Section 2 – Entry and Eligibility requirements include:

- The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club.
- Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.
- AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for all entries.
- A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in the class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler.

# **PeeWee Special Attraction**

Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5–9 years of age. Children younger than five cannot participate in the Pee Wee Class Special Attraction. The safety of the children is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult. At an All-Breed Event the. A Specialty Club may have a Limited Status Junior Showmanship Judge that meets the criteria. The Judge MUST like children, be patient, kind, and have a sense of humor!

A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the PeeWee Class

Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate. If pre-entered, a dog may be substituted that meets the eligibility requirements as specified by the club.

All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.

A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.

At a Specialty Club Show the dogs must be of the breed(s) eligible for the event.

In addition to an entry form, a release must be signed by the child's parent or legal guardian.

#### Pee Wee Release of Liability

Sled Dog Class, Non-Degreed: A class for dogs and a class for bitches that have completed the necessary miles and/or races during the previous racing season to be eligible to enter the Sled Dog class (as defined below) but have not earned any of the SHCA sledding titles; or that have a "5 year proof" certificate. Sled Dog Class, SD Degreed: A class for dogs and a class for bitches that have earned the SHCA title of Sled Dog (SD) but have not earned any of other SHCA Sledding titles (SDX or SDO).

Sled Dog Class, SDX Degreed: A class for dogs and a class for bitches that have earned the SHCA title of Sled Dog Excellent (SDX).

Sled Dog Class, SDO Degreed: A class for dogs and a class for bitches that have earned the SHCA title of Sled Dog Outstanding (SDO).

# **Sled Dog Class Rules**

1. Entry must be an American Kennel Club or Canadian Kennel Club registered Siberian Husky (eligible under Chapter 15, Section 1, AKC Rules Applying to Registration & Dog Shows).

- 2. There will be a class for dogs and a class for bitches. At the discretion of the Show Chair additional classes may be offered based on the requirements of the Sled Dog Degreed Program.
- 3. If entered in a class for which a full entry fee was paid, no additional fee will be required to also exhibit in the Sled Dog class. The entry fee to exhibit solely in the Sled Dog class is free.
- 4. To qualify for entry in the Sled Dog Class, the dog must have completed one of the following three requirements:
- a)During the previous racing season, the applicant must complete ten (10) heats on snow with a minimum of four (4) miles per heat, or the total miles per season not being less than of the 48 miles up to 12 miles (25%) can come from Dryland Rig Races but the applicant must complete at least two (2) heats with a minimum of three (3) miles per heat. Dryland races must be on rigs. Rigs used must meet the definition of rig as defined by ISDRA (International Sled Dog Racing Association) under Dryland Races Rules. All races both snow and dry land must be under the direction of a Recognized Race giving Organization with rules and recorded results. A Race Season is from April 1 to March 31 of the following year.
- b) Entries who complete five (5) years in competition where the above rules are met shall be automatically qualified for the Sled Dog Class. A certificate of proof may be issued by the Chair of the Working Committee is the five (5) years of proof of competition records are sent in.
- c) Entries who have been awarded an SHCA Sled Dog Certificate, either SD, SDX, or SDO and are additionally eligible for entry in a conformation class at an AKC event, are eligible to compete in the Sled Dog Class.
- 5. Spayed or neutered dogs are not exhibited in the sled dog class as required by the SHCA Standing Rules.

A list of the races in which the dog competed, or a copy of the five-year certificate or a copy of the Sled Dog Degree must be sent to the Show Superintendent when the entry is made. Proof of qualification must be available at ringside with one of these shown is challenged.

The Show Superintendent shall request the following be provided with each entry to the Sled Dog Class: Each Dog's AKC Registered Name, AKC Registered Number, Sex, Race and Date of Race, miles per heat and Total miles, or five (5) year proof certificate, or copy of the Sled Dog Degree. ## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES

Novice Open Master

Novice Class – Shall be for boys or girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close and have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class. A first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Open Class – shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class or if a win in Novice leads to a Best Junior with competition present it will count as one win towards moving to Open in a licensed or member show.

Master Class – for boys and girls who are least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and must change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame

for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing to the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another, as well as, move from Master class to Open Class or Open Class to Novice Class if a win has been disallowed or the Junior miscalculated number of placement, provided this transfer is make by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

Notice: Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Number on each entry. You may obtain your junior identification number by calling the AKC 919 233-9767.

Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes are entered on the front and back of the entry form, otherwise the entry in Junior Showmanship will not be accepted.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the weekend, however, current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship may participate in NOHS.

Owner-Handled Best of Breed, will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition, including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the winners of the non-regular classes.

\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handler's organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves a handling for pay within the last five years.
